Supplies

Fabric

Main Fabric : 1x fat quarter

Accent fabric : 1 x fat eight

Insulated batting : 8" x 11" (20.5 x 28cm)

Cotton Batting : 8" x 18" (20.5 x 46cm)

Bias tape 1/2" (1.2cm) double fold : 1 1/4" yard

Bias tape maker 1" (25mm) if making your own bias tape

Fabric basting glue stick

Notes:

• *Fabric requirements are estimated to make
1x potholder.*

*More fabric maybe needed if
using directional print.*

• *If opt for solid design (no applique) you
will need approximately 1/4 yard of the main
fabric + 11" x 11" (28cm x 28cm) accent fabric
to make the bias tape (unless using premade
bias tape)*

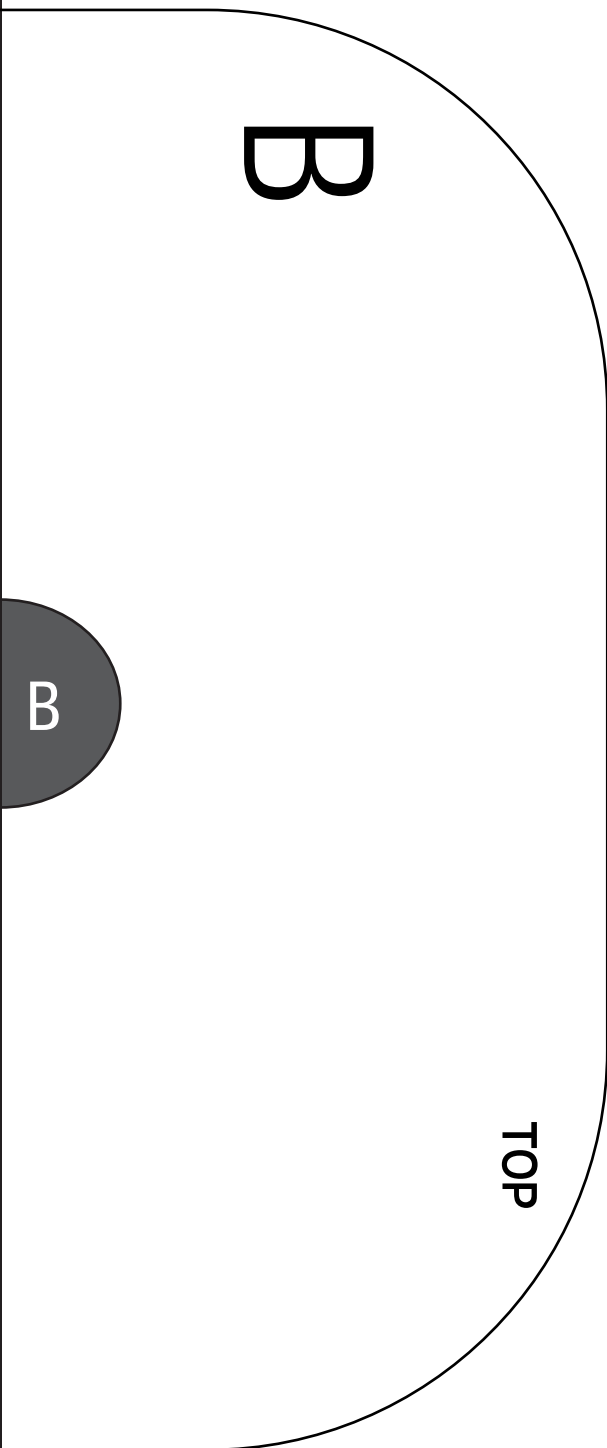


Autumn Potholder

Main Body

- Cut 1x each front and back
 - Cut 1x insulated batting
 - Cut 1 x cotton batting

Cutting

Hand Pocket : Pattern A

Cut (1) each front and back panel

Cut (1) cotton batting

Main Body : Pattern B

Cut (1) each front and back panel

Cut (1) cotton batting

Cut (1) insulated batting

Pumpkin Applique :

Cut (1) each piece 1,2,3

Cut (3) piece 4

Hanging Loop : Cut 3 1/2" (9cm) long strip
from the bias tape

Bias Tape (if making your own using the same
method as me) :

Cut (1) 11" x 11" / (28 x 28cm)*

**the above measurement will yield enough
bias tape for 1x potholder.*

*If you make 2x potholders at the same time,
cut 15" x 15" (38 x 38cm) square.*

Seam allowances are 3/8" (1cm) unless otherwise stated
