Finished quilt measurements : $551 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2^{\prime \prime}(141 \times 161 \mathrm{~cm})$

## You will need :

42x Jelly roll strips - $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44^{\prime \prime}(6.4 \times 111 \mathrm{~cm})$ strips
1 x full bundle of jelly roll strips should suffice for this project, however each manufacturer may vary in the amount of strips given in a package, (somewhere between $38-45$ strips). If yours is less than 42 pcs, cut few extra strips in neutral colors to get the required amount. $2 / 3$ yard border fabric
$58 " \times 66$ " $(147 \times 168 \mathrm{~cm})$ batting https://amzn.to/3uoJkpl
3 1/2 yard backing fabric
$1 / 2$ yard binding fabric
Note: yardage requirements are estimated, based on standard 44" wide cotton quilting fabric.
Machine quilting thread (if opt machine quilting) https://amzn.to/36z6Xuc Basic sewing/quilting notions

## Cutting

Fabric 1 Cut $2 \times$ from each jelly roll strip : $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times(6.4 \times 16.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ rectangles


Fabric 2 | Cut $2 \times$ from each jelly roll strip: $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.4 \times 14 \mathrm{~cm})$ rectangles Panel $3 \mid$ Cut $2 \times$ from each jelly roll strip : $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.4 \times 9 \mathrm{~cm})$ rectangles Panel $4 \mid$ Cut $2 \times$ from each jelly roll strip: $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.4 \times 6.4 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares


Border 1 I Cut $2 \times$ from the border fabric : $481 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}(123 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm})$
Border 2 I Cut $2 \times$ from the border fabric : $631 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}(161 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm})$
Binding strips I Cut (6x) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.4 \mathrm{~cm})$ strips from the width of fabric


## Making the blocks

Seam allowances are scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ ( 6 mm )

## Combo A

Sew fabric 1 \& 4 right sides together, press towards one side. Make in total of $84 x$ panels.

## Combo B

Sew fabric 2 \& 3 right sides together, press towards one side. Make in total of $84 x$ panels.


## Block Layout

Referring to the below diagram lay out $2 x$ combo $A$ and $2 x$ combo $B$. Sew them together, then press as indicated by the little arrows.


press as indicated by the little arrows

make in total of $42 x$ blocks
the finished block should measure 8 1/2" ( 21.5 cm )

## Assembly

1. Lay out your blocks in 7 rows, each row should have 6 blocks. Alternate the direction of each block as instructed in the video tutorial.
2. Sew the blocks one row at the time, alternate the pressing direction of each row.
3. Sew all the rows together, press towards one side.
4. Sew border 1 (short border), press towards border 1.
5. Sew border 2 (long border), press towards border 2.

## Finishing

Layer with batting and backing fabric, baste, then quilt and bind as desired.
