# Brick Work - Jelly Roll Quilt Pattern

## Finished quilt measurements : 55 1/2" x 63 1/2" (141 x 161 cm)


### You will need :

42x Jelly roll strips - 2 1/2" x 44" (6.4 x 111 cm) strips
1x full bundle of jelly roll strips should suffice for this project, however each manufacturer may vary in the amount of strips given in a package, (somewhere between 38-45 strips). If yours is less than 42 pcs, cut few extra strips in neutral colors to get the required amount.
2/3 yard border fabric
58" x 66" (147 x 168 cm) batting https://amzn.to/3uoJkpl
3 1/2 yard backing fabric
1/2 yard binding fabric
Note: yardage requirements are estimated, based on standard 44" wide cotton quilting fabric.

Machine quilting thread (if opt machine quilting) https://amzn.to/36Z6Xuc Basic sewing /quilting notions

## **Cutting**

Fabric 1 | Cut 2x from each jelly roll strip :  $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 6 \frac{1}{2} \times (6.4 \times 16.5 \text{ cm})$  rectangles Fabric 2 | Cut 2x from each jelly roll strip :  $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 5 \frac{1}{2} (6.4 \times 14 \text{ cm})$  rectangles Panel 3 | Cut 2x from each jelly roll strip :  $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{1}{2} (6.4 \times 9 \text{ cm})$  rectangles Panel 4 | Cut 2x from each jelly roll strip :  $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} (6.4 \times 6.4 \text{ cm})$  squares



Border 1 | Cut 2x from the border fabric :  $48 \ 1/2'' \times 4'' \ (123 \times 10 \ cm)$ Border 2 | Cut 2x from the border fabric :  $63 \ 1/2'' \times 4'' \ (161 \times 10 \ cm)$ 

Binding strips | Cut (6x) 2 1/2" (6.4cm) strips from the width of fabric

#### Making the blocks

Seam allowances are scant 1/4" (6mm)

#### Combo A


Sew fabric 1 & 4 right sides together, press towards one side. Make in total of 84x panels.

#### Combo B

Sew fabric 2 & 3 right sides together, press towards one side. Make in total of 84x panels.

#### Block Layout

Referring to the below diagram lay out 2x combo A and 2x combo B. Sew them together, then press as indicated by the little arrows.




make in total of 42x blocks

# **Assembly**

- Lay out your blocks in 7 rows, each row should have 6 blocks. Alternate the direction of each block as instructed in the video tutorial.
- Sew the blocks one row at the time, alternate the pressing direction of each row.
   Sew all the rows to act here.
- 3. Sew all the rows together, press towards one side.
- 4. Sew border 1 (short border), press towards border 1.
- 5. Sew border 2 (long border), press towards border 2.


