#### Finished quilt measurements : 70 1/2" x 81 1/2" (179 x 207 cm)

#### You will need :

I set of layer cake - (42x) 10" squares 2 1/3 yard of background fabric 5/8 yard border fabric 72" x 83"(183 x 211 cm) batting https://amzn.to/3uoJkpl 4 1/2 yard backing fabric 5/8 yard binding fabric Note: yardage requirements are an estimate, based on standard 44" wide cotton quilting fabric.

Machine quilting thread (if opt machine quilting) https://amzn.to/36Z6Xuc Basic sewing /quilting notions



## Fabric 1,2,3,4,5

Following the below diagram and the video tutorial, cut each layer cake fabric (42x each in total)



Fabric 6 | cut 84x from the background fabric : 1" x 4" (2.5 x 10 cm)Fabric 7 | cut 84x from the background fabric : 1" x 10" (2.5 x 25.4 cm)Fabric 8 | cut 84x from the background fabric : 11/4" x 10" (3.2 x 25.4 cm)Fabric 9 | cut 84x from the background fabric : 11/4" x 111/2" (3.2 x 29.2 cm)


**Border 1** | cut 2x from the border fabric :  $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 66 \frac{1}{2}$  (6.4 x 169.5 cm) **Border 2** | cut 2x from the border fabric :  $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 81 \frac{1}{2}$  (6.4 x 207.5 cm)


Binding | cut from the binding fabric (8) 21/2" strips from the width of the fabric


## Making the Blocks

Seam allowances are scant 1/4" (6mm)

Following the below diagram and the video tutorial, make in total of 42x blocks Finished block measurements :  $11 \frac{1}{2} \times 11 \frac{1}{2} (29.2 \times 29.2 \text{ cm})$


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

Fabric 1:  $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 10^{"}$  (6.4 × 25.4 cm) Fabric 2:  $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 10^{"}$  (9 × 25.4 cm) Fabric 3:  $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 4^{"}$  (6.4 × 10 cm) Fabric 4:  $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 4^{"}$  (9 × 10 cm) Fabric 5:  $4^{"} \times 4^{"}$  (10 × 10 cm) cut 42x each





#### Assembly

- 1. Lay out your blocks in 7 rows, each row should have 6 blocks. Alternate the direction of each block as instructed in the video tutorial.
- 2. Sew the blocks one row at the time, alternate the pressing direction of each row.
- 3. Sew all the rows together, press towards one side.
- 4. Sew border 1 (short border), press towards border 1.
- 5. Sew border 2 (long border), press towards border 2.

### Finishing

Layer with batting and backing fabric, baste, then quilt and bind as desired.
