Supplies

Fabric 1 : 1/2 yard cotton quilting fabric <https://bit.ly/3ZrVnSv>

Fabric 2: 1/4 yard of canvas fabric (60" wide) <https://tidd.ly/3VPXqwg>

Fabric 3: 3/4 yard of cotton quilting fabric <https://bit.ly/3xdjFf>

*yardage requirements for fabric 1&3 are an estimate, based on 44" wide cotton quilting fabric.

5/8 yard fusible woven interfacing - Pellon SF 101 (20" wide) <https://amzn.to/3bvgtLu>

10" x 4" (25.5 x 10 cm) one sided fusible foam stabilizer <https://amzn.to/3WLGbZA>

11" x 8" (28 x 20.5cm) clear vinyl fabric - gauge 8 recommended <https://amzn.to/3GlynqG>

(2x) 9" (23 cm) teeth length - metal zipper <https://tidd.ly/3Crj0k8>

14" (35.5 cm) teeth length - metal zipper <https://tidd.ly/3Crj0k8>

Abbreviation

FWI : Fusible Woven interfacing

FS : Foam Stabilizer

RS : Right Side

WS : Wrong side

Cutting

Exterior

Panel 1 (upper front)

Cut 1x each from Fabric 1 & FWI : 11" x 3" (28 x 7.5 cm)

Panel 2 (middle front)

Cut 1x each from Fabric 1 & FWI : 11" x 2" (28 x 5 cm)

Panel 3 (lower front)

Cut 1x each from fabric 1 & FWI : 11" x 7 1/2" (28 x 19.5 cm)

Panel 4 (lower front pocket)

Cut 1x from fabric 3 : 11" x 13" (28 x 33 cm)

Panel 5 (upper front pocket)

Cut 1x from Fabric 3 : 11" x 18" (28 x 45.5 cm)

Panel 6 (upper back)

Cut 1x from Fabric 2 : 11" x 5" (28 x 12.5 cm)

Panel 7 (lower back)

Cut 1x from Fabric 3 : 11" x 7 3/4" (28 x 20 cm)

Panel 8 (back slip pocket)

Cut 1x each from Fabric 1,3, & FWI : 11" x 9" (28 x 23 cm)



Zipper Tabs

Cut 4x from Fabric 1 : 2" x 1 1/2" (5 x 3.8cm)

Panel 9 (sides)

Cut 2x from Fabric 2 : 5" x 12" (12.5 x 30.5cm)

Panel 10 (bottom)

Cut 1x from Fabric 2 : 5" x 11" (12.5 x 28 cm)

Cut 1x from Foam Stabilizer : 4" x 10" (10 x 25.5 cm)

Panel 11 (d-ring tabs holder)

Cut 2 from Fabric 2 : 5" x 2" (12.5 x 5 cm)

Panel 12 (side pockets)

Cut 2 each from Fabric 2 & 3 : 5" x 9" (12.5 x 23 cm)

D-ring tabs

Cut 2x from Fabric 1 : 4" x 2 1/2" (10 x 6.5 cm)

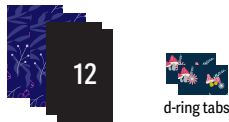
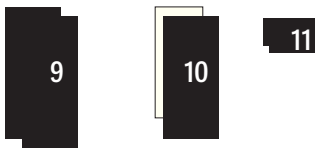
Adjustable strap

Cut from the webbing strap : 55" (140 cm)

Shoulder straps

Cut 2x from Fabric 1 : 24" x 3" (61 x 7.5 cm)

Cut 2x from FWI : 23" x 1 1/2" (58 x 3.8 cm)



Note:
If using cotton quilting fabric instead of canvas fabric for fabric 2, apply some FWI on the wrong side of panel 6, 9,10, 11, and 12

Interior

Panel 13 (upper front & back)

Cut 2x from Fabric 2 : 11" x 3" (28 x 7.5 cm)

Panel 14 (lower front & back)

Cut 2x from Fabric 3 : 11" x 9 3/4" (28 x 25 cm)

Panel 15 (upper sides)

Cut 2x from fabric 2 : 5" x 3" (12.5 x 7.5 cm)

Panel 16 (lower sides)

Cut 2x from Fabric 3 : 5" x 9 3/4" (12.5 x 25 cm)

Panel 17 (vinyl pocket)

Cut 1x from the clear vinyl : 11" x 8" (28 x 20.5 cm)

Panel 18 (vinyl pocket binding)

Cut 1x from Fabric 3 : 11" x 2" (28 x 5 cm)

Panel 19 (zipper pocket)

Cut 1x from fabric 3 : 10" x 15" (25.5 x 38 cm)

Panel 20 (bottom)

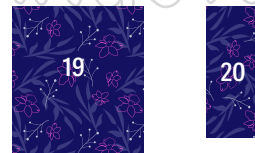
Cut 1x from fabric 3 : 5" x 11" (12.5 x 28 cm)

Panel 21 (zipper panels)

Cut 2x from Fabric 1 : 13 1/2" x 3" (34.5 x 7.5 cm)

Zipper Tab

Cut 1x from fabric 1 : 3" x 2" (7.5 x 5 cm)



Directions

Seam allowances are 3/8" (1cm) unless otherwise stated.
Please watch the Full Video Tutorial for thorough demonstration.

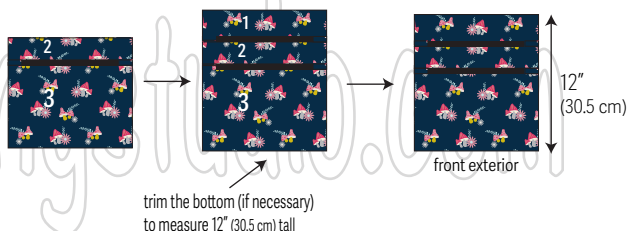
Preparation

1. Fuse the FWI to the wrong side of panel 1, 2, 3, 8, and shoulder straps (center the position).
2. Fuse the FS to the wrong side of panel 10 (center the position).

Bag Exterior

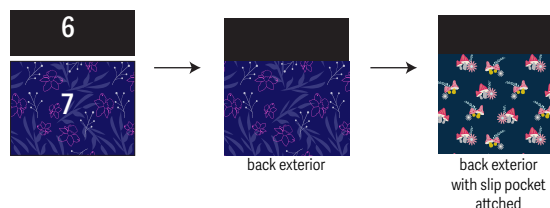
3. Install the zipper tabs on both 9" metal zippers (for the front pockets)
4. Sew and install the lower zipper pocket.
5. Sew and install the upper zipper pocket.

use 1/4" (6mm) seam allowance when installing the zipper pockets



6. Trim off the bottom so that the front exterior will measure 12" (30.5cm) tall, set aside.

7. With the RS facing, sew panel 6&7, press the seams open, topstitch.
8. Sew and install the back slip pocket.
9. Make the d-ring tabs then install them on the right side of the side panels.
10. Make adjustable strap, set aside.
11. Sew and install the shoulder straps.
- 12 Assemble the bag exterior.

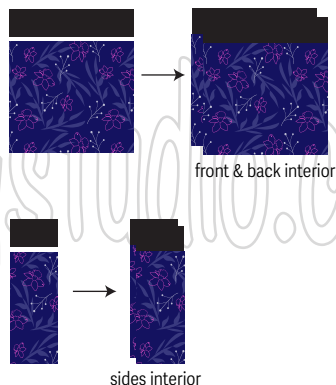


Bag Interior

13. With the RS facing, sew panel 13 & 14, press the seams open, topstitch.
14. With the RS facing, sew panel 15&16, press the seams open, topstitch
15. Sew and install the clear vinyl pocket.
16. Sew the zipper pocket.
17. Prepare the 14" zipper (for the zipper closure), install the zipper tab.
18. Make the zipper panels, then install them to the zipper. Set aside.
19. Assemble the bag interior, leave an opening at the bottom.

*Use 1/2" (1.2 cm) seam allowance when sewing the bottom panel.

20. Install the zipper closure.



Please watch the video tutorial thoroughly for visual presentation, and to avoid any confusion.

Assembling the bag, finishing.

21. With the RS facing, sew the bag exterior and interior.
22. Turn the bag right side out through the opening hole.
23. Finish the bag with topstitching, sew the opening hole to close it.
24. Attach the adjustable strap, and your bag is done.
